DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

How deep do you want to take your Group? Choose from these questions to lead your discussion.

- 1" Take turns reading Genesis 13:10- 16- What were the consequences of Lot's actions? Are there any practical warnings here for being led by our eyes?
- 2" What is the most prominent difference between Abram and Lot from a biblical point of view?
3. Verse 13 implies that the wickedness of Sodom was well known to others. What could have caused Lot to want to live close to it?
4. Ben mentioned, we ask the wrong question " how close can I get to a sin." Instead of asking "how close can I get to Jesus." What things do you tend to get close to instead of fleeing from?
5. Read Gen 14:12- notice the progression- 1st he is living close to Sodom, now hes living in Sodom. Have you witnessed the progression of sin in another persons life? Share without specifics.
6. Have you witnessed the progression of sin in your OWN LIFE before? Share with specifics.
7. Read Gen 19: 1-8- What does it mean that Lot is sitting in the gates of the city? What does Lot's position (city official) imply about his stance on wickedness?
8. Read Gen 19:9-14- Lot's own son-in-laws laughed at him as he tried to warn them. WHY did they respond this way?
9. Abraham always tried to help his nephew Lot- through sharing, giving him priority and delivering him in times of need. We want to follow this example rather than the example of Lot. This semester we are asking EVERY gGroup to serve their community during these difficult times. Think about an idea for the whole group this week and come ready to discuss and plan next week.
