DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

How deep do you want to take your Group? Choose from these questions to lead your discussion.

- 1. Take turns reading Luke 20:1-8. Where was Jesus and what was he doing when the religious leaders approached him with a question? What was their question and what could have lay behind it?
- 2. Read vs. 9-15- To whom does "a man" refer? In what way do "some tenants" represent mankind? God's people? What was the owner's desire?
- 3. What was in the owner's heart when he sent servants? To what extent did he persist? What does this reveal about the heart of the owner?
- 4. Where in your life have you experienced the patient love of God?
- 5. How did the tenants' evil actions escalate? What does this reveal about fallen man?
- 6. How can we relate to the tenants in this story? How do we reject the authority of Jesus in our lives?
- 7. Read vs. 16-18- What will the owner do? How was this parable fulfilled by Jesus? What did he mean by quoting Ps 118:22,23? What does this teach about God?
- 8. What does it mean to "dismantle your life" and start with Jesus?
- 9. Ben mentioned if we don't build our lives on Jesus he becomes a different kind of rock (vs. 18) have you ever experienced something crushed in your life?
- 10. Go around the circle and have everyone share where we can pray for them to keep Jesus as the cornerstone of their lives?
- 11. Discuss the area that your group will OWN at Easter EGG-splosion
- 12. Whats your 1st step to accomplish your OUTREACH PLAN for this semester?
