DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

How deep do you want to take your Group? Choose from these questions to lead your discussion.

- 1. Take turns reading LUKE 22:63–71. As believers, how are you moved by what Jesus endured on your behalf?
- 2. Why do the priests ask Jesus if he is the Christ? Why is that an offence to them, punishable by death?
- 3. How is Jesus' claim still so offensive in our world today?
- 4. How does this scripture refute the idea that Jesus never claimed to be God?
- 5. In what way does Jesus force the priests to make a decision? How does Jesus force the point with us as to who we are going to follow?
- 6. What does it means to you personally that Jesus is God. Why is it so important to spend an entire service talking about it?
- 7. Leaders read 2 Peter 2:1-3- What does it mean to deny the Lord that bought them? What are they teaching instead?
- 8. Ben mentioned that we can be LIKE the religious leaders when we stand in Judgment over Jesus. What does this mean?
- 9. It what ways have you chosen what you want to do over what God has told you to do in the past?
- 10. What teaching or direction from God in scripture is the most difficult to "just follow" for you?
- 11. How does Communion relate to this discussion today? Why do we observe it?
- 12. Discuss with group everyones Egg-splosion plans and outreach activity. Set dates for outreach.
