

## **AFFIRMATION OF GROWTH (15 MINUTES)**

- **Check in:** How did the challenge go the last 2 weeks? What's one thing that God has taught you in facing it or from revival week.
- **Pray:** Pray specifically for both those who struggled with the challenge and those who met their goal. Ask God to reveal truth and continue the work he began in each person.

## **BIBLE DISCOVERY (35 MINUTES)**

- **Big Idea (Watch Video):** As God's people are a blessing to the nations. Abraham models being a blessing to the other characters of Genesis.
- Bible Passage: Read Genesis 21:1-34 aloud (take turns)

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- 1. Describe the conflicts between Sarah, Hagar, and their sons.
  - What do you think about each person and how they interact?
  - Which characters actually belong to the Abrahamic covenant?
- 2. Abraham has to resolve conflicts and make some hard decisions.
- How does he resolve the conflict that Sarah has with Hagar?
- How does he provide for Hagar and Ishmael as he sends them?
- How does he confront the issues that arise with Abimelech?
- How does he resolve these problems and disputes?
- 3. What does this story teach us about God?
- How does God keep his promise to & through Abraham?
- How does God deal with his special covenant people?
- How does God deal those who are not part of the covenant?
- 4. How does the promise of blessing in Genesis 12:1-3 points to Jesus.
  - How does Abraham model this blessing to others?
- In what ways is Abraham a positive example to follow?
- As followers of Jesus, what is our role in blessing the nations?

## **CHALLENGE FOR LIFE (10 MINUTES)**

- **One Change:** Each person must identify one specific action to personally respond to the Word of God. Remember to be specific.
- Pray: Close by praying for our whole church family and our greater culture to respond to the Holy Spirit. Pray for Christian influencers, civil leaders, and socio-political decision makers.
