

**AFFIRMATION OF GROWTH (15 MINUTES)**

- **Check in:** Let each person share how their challenge went this week and one thing that God has taught them in facing it.
- **Pray:** Pray specifically for both those who struggled with the challenge and those who met their goal. Ask God to reveal truth and continue the work he began in each person. Each person can offer a simple one sentence prayer. “Lord, I praise you, because \_\_\_\_\_”

**BIBLE DISCOVERY (35-45 MINUTES)**

- **Big Idea (Watch Video):** God’s people thrive when they follow his ways.
- **Bible Passage:** Read Leviticus 26:1-2, 26:3-13, 26:14-26, 26:27-46.
- **Discussion Questions:**
  1. What are God’s expectations for his people?
    - Why is idolatry such a problem (or why is right worship so important)?
    - How does the law help us honor God in all our ways?
  2. What promises does God make for those who walk by his commands (26:3-13)?
    - Discuss the produce of the land, military success, population growth, and the presence of God as it applies to Israel. How does it apply now to the Christian Church.
  3. What penalties/curses come for those who refuse to abide in God’s law (26:14-39)?
    - What indications do we have that God is disciplining them and expecting repentance?
  4. What promises are available if the people repent (26:40-46)?
    - What impact should this teaching have on us? Must we confess sin? Must we forgive?

**CHALLENGE FOR LIFE (10 MINUTES)**

- **One Change:** Has this passage revealed a point of growth or a needed change? Is there something you must voice in order to better obey God? Remember to be specific about your action as you seek to respond to God in humility and obedience.
- **Narrow it down to an “I will” statement:** I will \_\_\_\_\_
- **Closing Prayer:** Pray for each member to be faithful to their challenge in the coming week. Remember to pray for one another when the notes come out. And continue to pray for Revival—that people far from God are drawn close and are ultimately saved.
