

AFFIRMATION OF GROWTH (15 MINUTES)

- Check in:Let each person share something about themselves, one thing God is teaching them in life, and something they hope to get out of gGroups this semester. (Leader I would write these down so you can know how to encourage and guide your group this semester).

BIBLE DISCOVERY (35-45 MINUTES: WHAT 10 MINUTES, SO WHAT 10-20 MINUTES, AND NOW WHAT 15-20 MINUTES)

- Watch Video
- **Big Idea for gGroup:** Unchecked sin affects our bond with God, warps our ties with others, and fractures our families. Confront sin with repentance and obedience.
- WHAT? (To allow great discussion we will not cover every Bible verse read on Sunday or in the chapter)
 - o Read 1 Samuel 1:10-11
 - What actions did Hannah take with wanting a child?
 - o Read 1 Samuel 1:19-28
 - Did God answer Hannah's prayer?
 - When was Hannah ready to give the LORD Samuel? (Fun fact weaning could take up to 3 years).
 - o Read 1 Samuel 2:12-17, 22-24
 - What actions did Eli's sons do to become corrupt?
 - How did Eli discipline them? Did it work?
 - o Read 1 Samuel 2:18-21, 26
 - How do we know Hannah and Elkanah never stopped caring and loving Samuel?
 - How did God bless Hannah and Elkanah's trust in Him?
 - How was Samuel opposite of Eli's sons?
 - o Read 1 Samuel 2:30-36
 - What was God going to do with Eli and his family?
 - What are the characteristics of the faithful priest God was going to raise up?
- SO WHAT?
 - O Does God want us to make vows?
 - What does God require of parents after reading about these two families?
 - What does sin do in our lives when left unchecked?
 - o If you were in Eli's shoes after hearing the prophecy about your sons what would you do?

NOW WHAT?

- What is something that is heavy on your heart that you need to bring to God?
- What is one action you can take as a parent to point your kids to God or repentance? If not a parent, is there a character from today's story that you relate too?
- o Anyone want to share a story of a time they left sin unchecked and how it affected your life?

CHALLENGE FOR LIFE (10 MINUTES)

One Challenge: Has this passage revealed a point of growth or a needed change? Is there something
you must do or voice in order to better obey God? Be specific and narrow it down with an "I will"
statement
