WEEK THREE

Monday

Saturday


2 Thessalonians 3:1-5

PURPOSE OF THIS GUIDE

WEEK ONE

Monday

PSALM 42:1-2

Tuesday

Romans 15:30

Pray for the leaders of Guide Church to have clear direction and wisdom as they lead the church and their specific area of ministry.

Wednesday

Proverbs 3:5-8

Thursday

Colossians 4:2-4

Friday
