## BIBLE DISCOVERY (35-45 MINUTES: WHAT 10 MINUTES, SO WHAT 10-20 MINUTES, AND NOW WHAT 15-20 MINUTES)

- Watch Video
- Big Idea for gGroup: God calls us to seek reconciliation and unity, even when it's hard.
- WHAT? (To allow great discussion we will not cover every Bible verse read on Sunday or in the chapter)
  - o Read 2 Samuel 19:1-8
    - Why was Joab upset with David?
    - What do you notice about the way David responded to Joab's rebuke?
  - o Read 2 Samuel 19:9-15
    - What disagreement was happening among the tribes of Israel?
    - How did David win back the loyalty of the tribe of Judah?
  - o Read 2 Samuel 19:16-23
    - Back in 2 Samuel 16, what wrong had Shimei done to David and the people fleeing with him?
    - How do we learn about repentance and reconciliation from the way David responded to Shimei?
  - o Read 2 Samuel 19:24-30, 2 Samuel 16:1-4
    - How did Ziba deceive David earlier?
    - What decision did David make to resolve the conflict, and what do you think about his solution?
  - o Read 2 Samuel 19:31-40
    - Who was Barzillai, and how had he shown kindness to David?
    - How did King David try to repay Barzillai's kindness? Why did Barzillai turn him down?
  - o Read 2 Samuel 19:41-20:2
    - What new argument broke out between the tribes of Israel?
    - What was the outcome of the argument, and what does it show about the nation at this point?
- SO WHAT? (If you like to get this section started you can ask, "what stood out to you from the Bible?")
  - o What stood out to you about all the different interactions in chapter 19?
  - o Do you feel David handled each situation well? Why or why not?
  - What can we learn about how division starts among families, friends, or even in a church?
- NOW WHAT?
  - What steps can we take to prevent division in our family, friends or church?
  - o How challenging is it to reconcile with someone that really hurt you? How does God call us to respond?
  - Looking at David's choices in this chapter, what is one specific application you can take into your own relationships?
